

Since launching our outdoor escape games two years ago, we have successfully worked with a variety of schools, who have used our games as a way of incorporating health and wellbeing into their curriculum. Our outdoor escape games can be set up in most areas and engage pupils of all ages and provide a fun and unique immersive learning experience.

How do outdoor escape games work?

We have two outdoor escape games to choose from: 'Magic Portal', or 'Operation Mindfall'. Both games have a duration of 2 hours, and as we come to you, you don't have to think about transport costs. Games can be set up to be played around your school site or in a location of your choosing if you prefer. Your pupils will play the game in teams, which therefore encourages teamwork and effective communication. The games also enable children to use problem solving skills in a realistic context and use critical thinking skills. Each team will be provided with an iPad and an action pack, which is everything that they need to complete their mission!

This is a physical activity, the games are played outside and teams are moving from different puzzle locations and are working against the clock.

As well as our outdoor games we have two Indoor escape room games at our premises in the iconic Pryce Jones building in Newtown. There are suitable for children from 10 years of age there is no upper age limit.
